Sapa recently completed the flagship traffic signal installation in Ceredigion, West Wales. The scheme was part of a major development in the town of Ceredigion which saw the supermarket giant Tesco opening its new Welsh branch. The feeder roads to the supermarket were specified and equipped with Sapa Traffic Signal Poles and lighting columns.

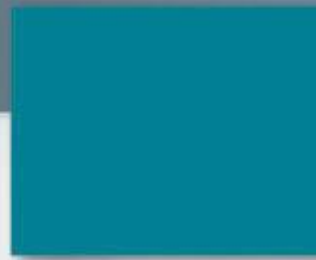
